

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER Oak Hills Ranch (PWS ID TX0940085), Guadalupe County, Texas

Lead and Copper Monitoring and Reporting Violation July 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023

Oak Hills Ranch Water PWS ID TX0940085 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing (or did) to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During July 1, 2023 – December 31, 2023, we did not monitor or test for LCR and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for [these contaminants], how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which the follow-up samples were [or will be] taken.

What is being done?

CSWR-Texas is implementing systems to improve monitoring and reporting of such parameters. The lead and copper samples will be collected prior to the June 30th deadline.
