

Dear Oak Tree Subdivision Customer,

Oak Hill UOC, a member of the Central States Water Resources (CSWR) family of companies, is proud to be your community's wastewater service provider since September 30, 2018. Over that time, we have worked closely with state regulatory agencies to ensure we are consistently in full compliance with all regulations by meeting or exceeding standards for service. Across the state of Arkansas, CSWR has invested more than \$5.1 Million into sewer utility infrastructure, significantly increasing the quality and reliability of service for all our customers, and would like to provide you with an overview of the improvements we are making in your community.

Ongoing and completed projects at Oak Tree wastewater facility:

- A complete overhaul of disinfection and treatment processes
- Repair of critical components at the treatment facility, including piping, valves, and tankage
- Installation of updated technology (MBBR system) to meet environmental discharge quality requirements
- Installation of a 'quick-connect' for backup generator power to minimize outage time length
- Installation of remote monitoring systems at the treatment facility to detect potential problems before they affect quality ore reliability of services provided.

Oak Hill seeks to charge fair and reasonable rates to customers. These investments in infrastructure and daily operations will require an increase in the rates for your wastewater service. **Your monthly rate will increase from \$60 per month to \$76 per month**. Customers can expect their bill that will mail in mid-August to contain these new rates.
