Monitoring and Reporting Violation for Chemical Sampling Triennial (January 1 2020-December 31 2022)

The **FARRAR WSC** water system **PWS ID TX1470007** has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to collect and submit chemical samples of water provided to their customers, and report the results of those samples to the TCEQ on a regular basis.

We failed to monitor and/or report the following constitutes: Gross Alpha (excluding radon and uranium), Combined Uranium, and Combined Radium (226 and 228).

This/These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period(s): January 1, 2020-December 31,2022.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from chemical contamination. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for chemical constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

We are implementing procedures to ensure that all required samples are analyzed and reported in a timely manner.
